If you don't pay for prescriptions, you may be able to use the NHS Minor Ailment Scheme to get advice and, when appropriate, FREE treatment for certain illnesses without seeing a GP. Minor illnesses such as cold, cough, diarrhoea, conjunctivitis and head lice are covered. Speak to your local pharmacist for eligibility and whether the illness is covered by the scheme.
